Dancing with the Stars' Mirrorball Trophy is made from a solid-spun brass stem and CNC-routed letters—both plated in 24-karat gold; a piano lacquer wood base; and an 8-in., \$10 plastic mirror ball ordered online.

"It's supposed to be a funny, comical award...the whole show is very tongue in cheek, so we craft this beautiful, high-quality sculpture and then affix the cheap plastic mirror ball to it. The incongruity is what makes it great." said David Moritz, founder and CEO of Society Awards.

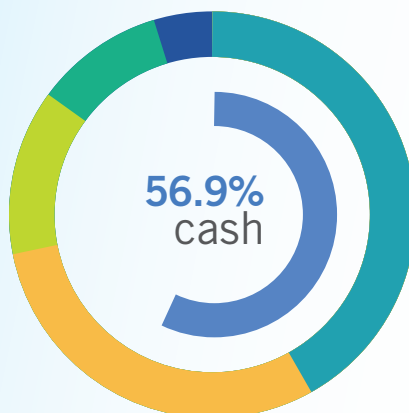
